As Colorado community college students, you have an excellent opportunity to pursue a career in nutrition and dietetics by following these 3 steps:

1. Enroll in the courses outlined below to seamlessly transfer from CCCS to BS in Nutrition at MSU Denver with any degree from a community college that includes these 47 credits.
2. Take an additional 13-17 credits to complete your Associates Degree. They will be awarded as Nutrition pathway elective credits, as long as they are transferable credits.
3. Consider pursuing our MS in Human Nutrition and Dietetics if you wish to pursue a career as a Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN) via our 3+2 accelerated program.
