From CCCS to MSU Denver's Bachelor of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics and/or 3+2 Program for Bachelor of Science and Master of Science in Human Nutrition and Dietetics

As Colorado community college students, you have an excellent opportunity to pursue a career in nutrition and dietetics by following these 3 steps:

- 1. Enroll in the courses outlined below to seamlessly transfer from CCCS to BS in Nutrition at MSU Denver with any degree from a community college that includes these 47 credits.
- 2. Take an additional 13-17 credits to complete your Associates Degree. They will be awarded as Nutrition pathway elective credits, as long as they are transferable credits.
- 3. Consider pursuing our MS in Human Nutrition and Dietetics if you wish to pursue a career as a Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN) via our 3+2 accelerated program.
