Gun Sight Installation - June 14-18, 2021

This course covers the installation of sights on barrels for rifles or handguns or slides on pistols. The class will cover drilling and tapping, silver solder, and cutting dovetails. We will discuss measuring the barrel to determine the correct height of the sights. Bring the projects that you will be installing sights on, as well as the sights to be installed. Experience using a drill press or milling machine is a plus, but not mandatory.
