With the \$3.8 billion of state aid provided by the American Rescue Plan Act, the Governor and Colorado legislature have allocated approximately \$200 million towards workforce development and education. Through HB21-1330 the Colorado Opportunity Scholarship Initiative (COSI) received \$46.5 million to expand its Finish What You Started (FWYS) program, focusing on providing direct and indirect support to students.
