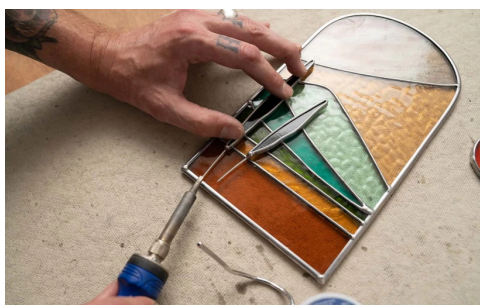

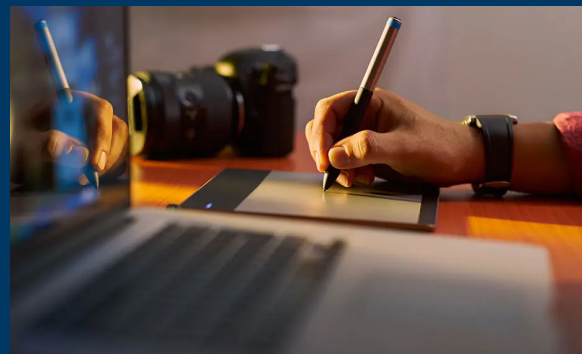

DIGITAL ARTS



This online Digital Arts Certificate course will help you develop technical skills and creative artistry in digital photography, imaging, and illustration. This course covers Adobe Photoshop and Illustrator and more.

Hands-on projects focus on core skills and provide you with experience in traditional and digital media. Class assignments include digital imaging, vector drawing, traditional drawing, color and composition, and editorial illustration.

Enroll anytime, the course is self-paced and consists of 360 course hours.

Note: This is a non-credit, online certificate program. The tuition is \$3,495 for twelve months of access to complete the certificate. The program is not eligible for traditional financial aid, but financing is available through Ed2Go.

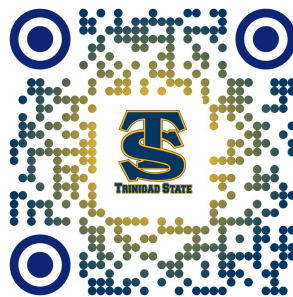
