As one of just four National Rifle Association (NRA) affiliated Gunsmithing schools in the country, aspiring gunsmiths come from across the nation to learn the gunsmithing trade at Trinidad State. Started in 1947 by legendary gunsmith and custom rifle maker P.O. Ackley, Trinidad State's Gunsmithing Program now holds the reputation as *America's Premier Gunsmithing School*. A highly sought-after program, around 70 prospective students apply for the two-year Gunsmithing Program each semester, but only 17 are accepted after a thorough screening and application process. **Read More**
