





1960 Presidential Election Reaches Trinidad

The 1960 U.S. presidential election between John F. Kennedy and Richard Nixon unfolded during the Cold War and the early days of the space race. In 1957, the Soviet Union had launched Sputnik, the world's first artificial satellite, signaling its technological prowess and sparking fears that the U.S. was falling behind. During their campaigns, both candidates emphasized the importance of leadership in facing Soviet competition.


